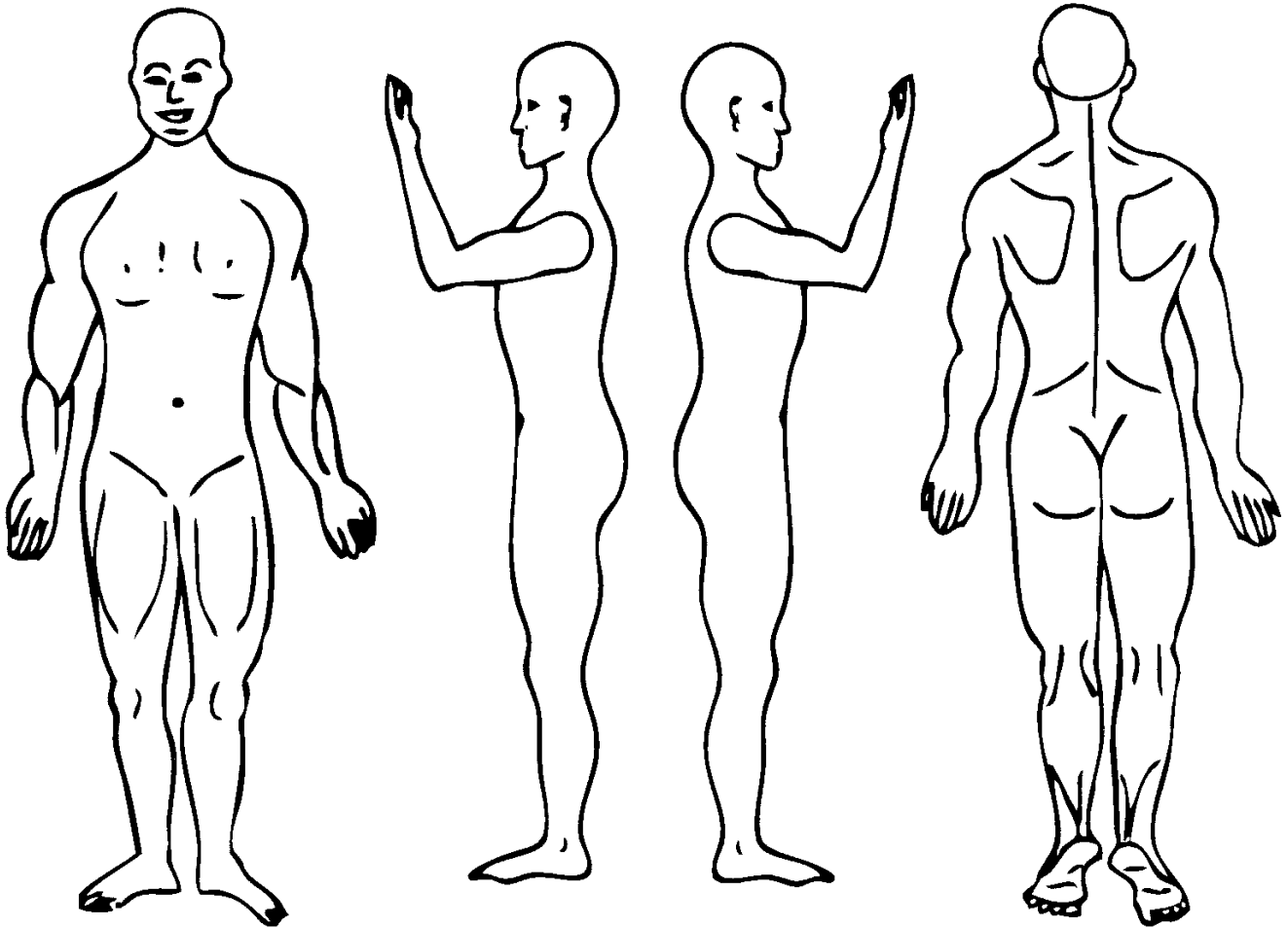

Directions
